## WHY ART FOR OZ FIRES?

Art For Oz Fires is different to many other arts fundraising events, in that we intend to maintain our online store as an ongoing source of fundraising. Extreme bush fire conditions are likely to be a continuing issue in Australia and those affected are going to require support and nurturing in the long term. An online store has the potential to facilitate fundraising for longer than a one-off event, auction or sale. The Art For Oz Fires site will also be open to both donations and buyers interstate or internationally.

## WHERE DOES THE MONEY GO?

This fund is held by the Fremantle Foundation as a separate Named Fund and everything raised will be distributed to not-for-profit organisations assisting with fire relief (facilitated by a 2% fee). Specific direction of funds will be nominated by Art For Oz Fires from the approved list of registered DGR1 charities, collated by the Freo Fire Fund. # ART FOR OZ FIRES

## TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. One completed application is required per artwork.
2. Applicants must be the Artist/Creator of the work. We are seeking submissions by practicing established, emerging or part-time artists, designers, artisans, craftspeople or creatives.  
All artworks should be of a quality fit for sale to the public.
3. Artworks of any medium are welcome to be submitted, provided they are a physical item of some kind - eg. painting, sculpture, print, photography, textile, etc.
4. Images must be a true representation of the work. Image/s of the work must match the work's description (ie. Image must show a framed work, if description states that it is framed).
5. Please submit images that accurately represent the artwork in terms of cropping, exposure, colour and clarity.
6. We reserve the right to refuse any inappropriate artwork.
7. Artworks donated are gratefully accepted as a 100% donation by the Artist/Creator....
8. By submitting this application, the Artist/Creator agrees that he/she is willing and able to provide a physical work to the Buyer. Artists/Creators will be notified once their work has sold and it is both the responsibility and a requirement of the Artist/Creator to arrange for the artwork to transfer into the Buyer's possession. Artists/Creators shall be responsible for ensuring safe delivery or transfer of the artwork to the Buyer via agreed pick up or shipping. Art For Oz Fires holds no responsibility for either delivery or time of delivery of items to Buyers.
9. For Buyer pick-up, artworks should be collected from the Artist/Creator's home or studio or other suitable location and must be available for collection within 7 days of the Artist/Creator being notified of the sale.
10. If you have chosen to make shipping available, arrangement for delivery should be negotiated directly between the Artist/Creator and the Buyer and should include shipping insurance.  
Shipping arrangements must be agreed on either prior to purchase, or within 7 days of the Artist/Creator being notified of the sale.
11. Artworks should be shipped within 14 days of receiving shipping payment. The Artist/Creator is liable for safe packing and delivery of artworks and is liable to compensate the Buyer for any damages incurred during delivery of an uninsured artwork.
12. The Artist/Creator is responsible for insuring he/she receives the correct amount for packing and shipping from the Buyer.
13. The Artist/Creator's private information will be stored only for purposes of auditing.
